For example, if you have a hearing aid company, do you have a large ear to place on the table to get attention? Or an excavation company? Put Tonka trucks on the table. An accounting company? Have a calculator with tape spilling out.

Do not forget to have your name somewhere! Members need to know who you are!

Don't forget to add your call to action to your display. This is how potential customers can patronage your business.

Examples: Call to set up your appointment, Visit our website, Visit our store.

Please don't solicit donations of any kind through your display.



This is for a gardening company. They took items that they thought would not only look beautiful, but items that get attention.
